Annual Stickers (effective September 1 of each year) and punch cards must be purchased at the Town Clerk's Office or at the Transfer Station. One punch on a card is needed to dispose of one 30-gallon bag (up to 40 pounds). Other permitted materials are charged a specific fee listed above or by the cubic yard.

PLEASE RECYCLE:

We offer dual stream recycling as follows:

Mixed paper and cardboard: newspapers (inserts too), junk mail (plastic wrap removed), mixed office paper, magazines, books without hard covers, envelopes (windows okay), phone books, corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, boxboard (e.g. cereal boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes)

Containers: glass bottles and jars (lids okay), aluminum cans, steel (tin) cans, plastic bottles and jars (beverage, food, detergent/soap and beauty products), plastics labeled #1 through #7, lids okay, all containers should be rinsed clean.

Annual permit stickers (effective September 1 of each year)
must be purchased at the Town Clerk's Office or at the Transfer Station
